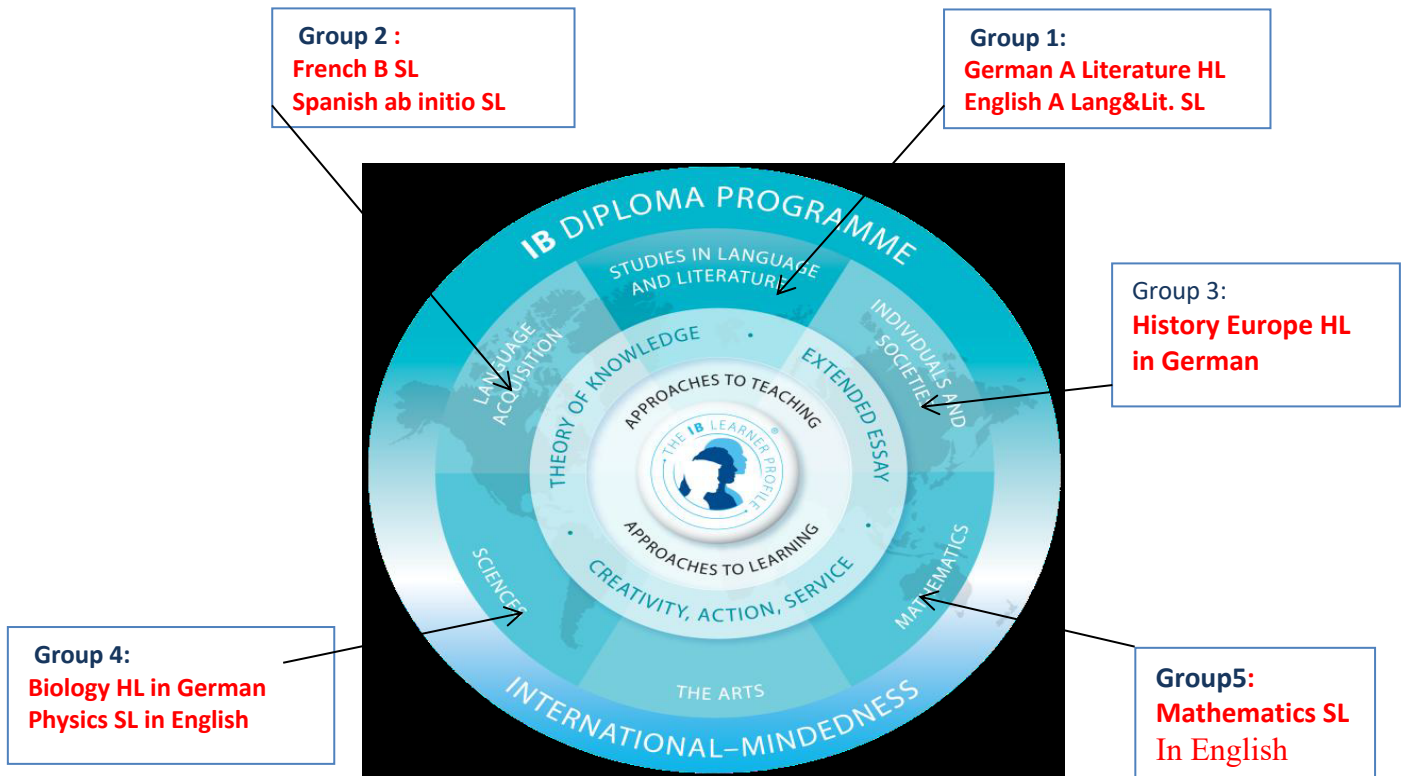

The mission of ERS school

The mission of The Privatschule der Deutschen Botschaft (ERS) is to prepare students to become life-long learners and positive contributors to their local and global communities. Tolerance, a sense of responsibility, respect for other cultures, the environment and nature characterise all of our thinking and actions. Politely dealing with one another and helpfulness are as important as motivation and skillfulness. The students will be able to compete with others internationally in several different fields and will be flexible in adapting to new situations.

IB Diploma Programme DP Model



IB Diploma Requirements:

Students must take 3 Higher Level (HL) and three Standard Level (SL) courses. One course from each of group 1-5, and 6th subject from either group 6 or any other group.

- **Higher Level (HL)**
240 recommended hours
- **Standard Level (SL)**
150 recommended hours
- **Complete Core requirements: EE, CAS, TOK**

In addition to the academic subjects, three important features of IB are shown in the centre of the model as the core parts:

- **Theory of Knowledge (TOK):**

A challenging course unique to the IB, that requires at least 100 teaching hours over the two-years programme, with the aim to develop a critical approach and ability to question the basis of knowledge.

- **Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS):**

The CAS programme encourages students to get involved in projects as Theatre, production, sports, music and community service activities for personal development through experiential learning.

- **Extended Essay (EE):**

An essay of 4000 words, as a result of approximately 40 hours of private study of a subject of special interest is selected, researched and documented by the DP student.

Points in IB:

- Each subject is assessed in its own way, then graded with a score of 1-7:
 $6 \times 7 = 42$ points
- Up to 3 bonus points are awarded for TOK & EE according to a matrix
 $42 + 3 = 45$ points
- No extra points are awarded for CAS, but a student must show regular commitment to be awarded the Diploma – Periodically, Schools are requested to send evidence of student's CAS achievement to the regional office in April.

Elective Subjects offered:

- Physics – SL in English
- Spanish AB – SL in Spanish
